## STAR-STUDDED EVENT

Stirling-based jeweller Simon Sturt Bray has resisted the temptation to make anything too bold for the Helpmann Academy's annual Maestros and Apprentices gala event.

While Simon is known for using beautiful but unusual gems in his jewellery, he has opted for something a little more familiar for the piece he is donating to the evening's auction.

"I wanted to reflect the event's theme of Starry Starry Night without actually doing a star which is a bit cliché," he says.

"I wanted a piece that was organic but white and sparkling."

The result is a ring, hand pierced and hand made, which blends diamonds and white gold in a contemporary style. It has a retail value of \$4500.

The Maestros and Apprentices event is a major fundraising event for the Helpmann Academy, which supports Adelaide's arts schools through its grants program.

It draws on the talents of experienced and emerging visual artists who contribute items for two auctions – one public and one silent - while ongoing entertainment is also provided by the musicians, singers, dancers and actors from the Academy's partner schools.

Another Hills-based artist, Corinna Freytag, is the "apprentice" jeweller also contributing her work.

In the final year of her visual arts degree at the University of SA, Corinna, who lives with her family at Ironbank, says she likes the reciprocal nature of the event where arts students contribute work to a fundraising event that supports their schools.

Corinna's contribution, a bracelet made from knitted wire and freshwater pearls, will be part of the silent auction.
